After submitting your online Application for Graduate Admission to Boise State, you will receive a letter from the Graduate College confirming your application. Included will be your student ID number, a Registration Certificate with information on dates and times for registration, and contact information for the degree plan you've chosen. You'll have a [BroncoWeb](#) account set up where you'll be able to access your student information, print unofficial transcripts, and monitor progress through your degree program. You'll also receive an email account for communications between you and your advisor, the Graduate College, and Boise State University.
